The project is aimed at first-year students, especially those at risk of dropping out, and is funded by the World Bank, headquartered in Washington D.C. - USA, through the External Financing Project Management Unit (UMPFE) of the Ministry of National Education (MEN). The main activities of the project are counseling and tutoring.

Regarding counseling activities, they are addressed to all first-year students from all faculties within UOC, especially targeting students who fall into the at-risk category (direct target group), but other first-year students can also participate (secondary target group). The activities will be supported by teaching staff from the Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences.

As part of the project, I organized several workshops on Professional Development Opportunities and the ERASMUS+ program.

During the Professional Development Opportunities workshops, together with the targeted guests, we established to discuss and develop mainly the following aspects:

- 1. Presentation of the experience and professional trajectory of present graduates.
- 2. Professional development opportunities in the field of local and central public administration.
- 3. Presentation of good practices in policy development.
- 4. Correlating theoretical and practical knowledge with the chosen study program.
- 5. Insertion into the job market upon completion of studies.

During the ERASMUS+ program workshops that will be organized, together with the targeted guests, we established to discuss and develop mainly the following aspects:

- 1. Presentation and interactive discussions regarding the Erasmus student status, from the perspective of opportunities and advantages of benefiting from a study or internship scholarship.
- 2. Presentation of study and internship mobilities within the Erasmus+ program (advantages, destinations, usefulness, expectations) to increase appetite for submitting a candidacy.
- 3. Presentation of the conditions for obtaining a scholarship within the program, preparation of the candidacy file, organizational details, information regarding the selection interview.
- 4. Presentation of mobilities carried out by some faculty students as an exemplification and clarification of some aspects related to situations of good practice.
